We are pleased to confirm this year's ACW programme for the Remove. ACW aims to combine fun with building self-confidence and life skills, away from the routines and constraints of the classroom.

Monday 3 July: Outdoor Guernsey Day

Registration by Mim's kiosk at Cobo at 08:25. Students will be dismissed from there at 15:30.

We appreciate that a morning drop-off on the west coast is not ideal when many parents work in town, but the buses we would normally hire to transport students from college to the coast are used for scheduled school runs at that time of day. A later start would also result in the students losing out on one of the activities. We hope options such as active travel, public transport, and car-sharing can minimise the inconvenience.

The girls will rotate between three activities, all led by Outdoor Guernsey instructors. A Ladies' College teacher will accompany each group.
