Year 12 Geography Fieldwork June 12th -15th 2023

Dear Parents and Guardians

The Year 12 Geographers are undertaking four days of fieldwork from June 12th to 15th. The reason we have set-up these four days is that fieldwork is a compulsory part of the A-level course. Each student is required to complete four days of fieldwork over the duration of the two-year course. The students will also collect most of their data for their A-level coursework, which is worth 20% of their final A-level mark. This coursework is due to be completed towards the end of the Michaelmas Term.

What to bring?

Please bring your fully charged **laptop** into Elizabeth College. They can be left in Room PC5 when you are out doing fieldwork. You will also need a **packed lunch**, water bottle and suntan lotion for Days 2,3 and 4. Please wear suitable clothes for doing fieldwork, such as wearing walking kit not jeans. Check the weather forecast the night before.

Remote Supervision

Please note that there will some remote supervision on these fieldwork days, for example, when the students will be in small groups carrying out surveys in St Peter Port or taking beach and sand dune measurements along the coast in Guernsey or Herm.

Some students will also make their own way to their fieldwork sites on the Thursday morning.
