### Duke of Edinburgh's Silver Qualifying Expedition

Following a successful practice expedition, I am pleased to share the itinerary for our qualifying expedition. The group will be accompanied by myself and Mrs Sarah Duguid. As with the practice, upon arrival in The Lake District, the expedition will be run by DofE Approved Activity Provider, 'The Adventure Element'. I am once again including the guidance pack for participants and parents that was shared with you prior to the practice expedition. As per the practice, most team kit will be provided when we arrive in The Lake District, but individual kit will need to be packed as detailed in the guidance. Girls should ensure there is room in their rucksacks to add group kit on arrival.

We will be planning meals prior to departure and groups will be expected to have the majority of their expedition food packed to bring with them. We have, however, arranged an opportunity to purchase any fresher items that may be needed on arrival.

Although Aurigny have advised that ID is not required, to ensure a smoother check-in process in Manchester, could I please ask that your daughter does bring photographic ID with her.

Due to the nature of the award, students will be remotely supervised throughout their expedition. During these times we will expect that the girls: stick to their planned route; notify their supervisor if they will not reach their allocated checkpoints at expected times; always remain in their groups. Students will be able to contact their supervisors and myself on their emergency phones at all times. Each group will also be provided with a tracker during their expedition so they can be easily located.
