

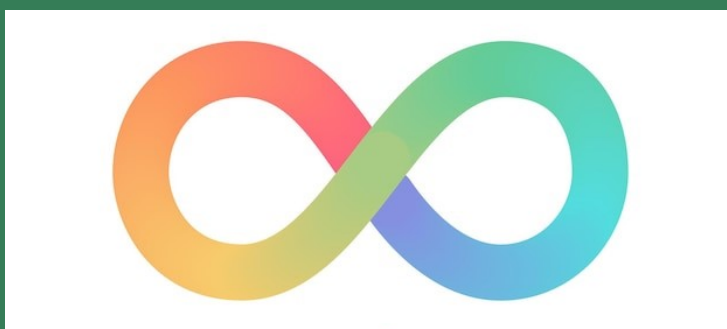

Parents and Carers and Professionals in Conversation



The States of Guernsey's Educational Psychology Service (EPS) and Communication, Interaction and Autism Service (CIAS) have been working in liaison with the Autism Diagnostic Service (ADS) and Autism Guernsey in order to address the needs of parents and carers whose children may have an Autism Spectrum Disorder.

The professionals from the Educational Psychology Service, Positive Behaviour Service, Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service and Autism Guernsey, will be delivering the input, with the latter half of the session then given over to listening to parent and carer experiences and addressing their questions.



Six sessions have currently been planned, to be delivered on Wednesday evenings, commencing in May 2023 and running until March 2024.
