### Did you know?

- That the States of Guernsey do not subsidise the College in any building development capacity, and therefore all funds needed to improve facilities have to be sourced by our own efforts
- That the College has only been permitted by the States' to build up funding reserves since 2006
- That the Board of Governors secured a formal 25 year lease of the site in 2015, with an option to renew for a further 25 years, only if the College makes its own £10 million capital investment to the land and buildings in the first 25 year term
- Our recent well attended women's networking event celebrated the College and its role in supporting women, business and island life in general. A champagne reception included wonderful performances by our girls. Sponsored by Rothschilds, this event showed that there is continued support from our Old Girls and the local community, and it is planned to make this a regular event
- That you can form a collective? Perhaps your daughter's year group could club together, each donate £100 and your class of 20 could together raise £2,000, with a brick saying, "Remove class of 2015"

### The builders are here!

In July, the huts were craned from their previous location to the staff car park behind the hall, where they had to be pieced back together, properly supported and made watertight once more.

They will remain here until our girls move into the new facility in September 2016, at which point they will be removed from the school site.

These huts are not suitable to teach in and in winter are very cold, and in summer are too hot. The huts house geography, business studies, economics, maths and music.

### Time Capsule

Just before the half term break five time capsules were buried in the new build foundations. This included a box from each House (Brock, Carey, de Sausmarez, Durand) and one from Melrose. 'X' will mark the spot!

### Every pound counts

We welcome funds in any which way they come, such as cash, bank transfer or cheques.

If your donation is eligible for this scheme, we will receive extra funds. For example:


- From a £5,000 donation (£10,000 for a married couple), in a calendar year, this yields an extra £1,250 for the College
