

Butterfield Bank Bursary

Butterfield Bank (Guernsey) Limited will award a bursary to a local student in respect of a three year degree course. Up to two bursaries may be awarded each year.

The value of the Bursary is £1,800.00 per annum over three years, equalling £5,400.00. This will be paid in separate instalments of £600.00 per term (in September, January and April). These payments will be made directly to the student's bank account.

Eligibility Requirements: A University place must have been offered and accepted, with the student having gained at least 300 UCAS points (eg 3 x B grades at A-Level). Preference will be given to students who are studying for degrees in Accountancy, Financial Services, Law, Business Studies etc.

Bursaries will not be offered to the children or close relatives of staff members.

Payment will be made subject to the continuation of study. If a student decides to leave the course they must inform the Bank's Human Resources department immediately, and payment will be stopped with immediate effect.
