The Board of Governors, in setting these fees, believe that they will ensure that the College continues to represent value for money against the highest standard of educational provision.

The continuing differential between Melrose fees and those of the Senior School and Sixth Form is as a result of the recent States' decision to continue to provide some financial support in the form of a grant to the College for students in the secondary phase of their education. It is with this funding agreement and a model based on at least maintaining numbers that we will aim to keep fees accessible to parents.

As with all schools, there is an element of the fee increase which enables the College to develop its provision further. Our focus remains student-centred, with developments in important areas of Learning Support and IT which are the key areas from our most recent inspection with ISI.
