The Department would like to take the GCSE and A-level groups to the Performing Arts Centre on Friday 19th October to see Splendid Productions' performance of 'Oresteia'.

As it is now a requirement of the new specifications of EDUCAS GCSE and A-Level Drama, that students demonstrate their knowledge of live productions – in GCSE by reviewing a piece of live theatre for their final written examination, and in A-level by analysing techniques observed in other actors / companies in their written examination - we would like to take advantage of seeing a professional production which is visiting the island. Some girls may have seen Splendid Productions' rendition of 'Metamorphosis' at the PAC last year, which provided a terrific source for examination tasks, as well as informing their own ideas for performance.

We ask that students be dropped off at the Performing Arts Centre at 08:45, a member of staff will be there from 08:30. There is no need to go to the school site first in order to register, but girls must wear their usual school uniform. I will be accompanying the girls to the performance with two other members of staff and we will take all students back to school on foot, following the workshop. As weather can be changeable, we advise that your daughter bring a waterproof coat for the walk back to school. If your daughter has a scooter and will be riding this back to school, please make a note of this on the return slip.
