Silver Duke of Edinburgh's Award

Silver Qualifying & Practice Expedition: 24th – 29th July 2019

Peak District - UK

Students will meet at Guernsey Airport at 08.20 on Wednesday 24th July. We will fly to Manchester where our Adventure Expeditions team will meet us and transport us back to Hathersage. We will spend the remainder of the afternoon and following day preparing our routes and getting all our kit ready. This will be a good opportunity to buy any last minute expedition equipment or food. Adventure Expeditions staff will be available to assist with this if needed. Students will enjoy two hearty evening meals ready for three days and two nights out on expedition. Students will walk a challenging route based on their current level of award. Students will have a free day on the 29th July and we plan on taking your daughter to the Open Air Swimming Pool for a well-deserved cool off and some down time after their expedition. We will travel back on the evening of the 29th. Your daughter will only need a small amount of spending money for lunches and snacks.

Cost: £510 (This cost is based on a minimum of 6 students participating).

.....What is included?

- All accommodation
- Two evening meals
- Private return transfers between Manchester Airport and Hathersage
- Use of all group equipment is included in the cost (tents, stoves, pots and pans, gas for stoves, group shelters, group first aid kits, maps, training materials and route planning briefs)
- Open Air Swimming Pool
- Qualified Mountain Leaders
- Qualified Assessors
- Insurance

Students will need to supply their own meals whilst on expedition which is part of their expedition preparation. They will need to plan and bring this with them from Guernsey, or alternatively purchase in Hathersage to save space in their backpacks. Backpacks will need to be checked in with Aurigny and we have a 20kg allowance.

Additional Cost

As with any trip it can be extremely difficult to budget whilst speculating on interested committed students and numbers required. You will note on my previous correspondence the cost per student was £475. Due to an increase in flight costs this has resulted in an increase of £35 per student.

Could we respectfully ask that deposits for the July trip are received by **Wednesday 29th May**. To date we have only received three, and this would not be sufficient to run a trip. Please note the previous and outstanding payment plans below.

Parents' evening

We will hold a parents evening on Thursday 13th June at 5pm in the Leaf Centre. This shouldn't last any longer than 60 minutes and you will have the opportunity to discuss the forthcoming trip with me.

We will provide a more detailed itinerary for your expedition and this will be provided to you at the parents meeting. In the meantime, should you have any further questions about the trips or costings please do not hesitate to email me.
