Alternative Curriculum Week (ACW): Lower Four

I am writing to you about Alternative Curriculum Week (Friday 28 June to Wednesday 03 July). The programme for Lower Four is outlined below and we hope it will provide many opportunities for developing interests and skills.

Please may I draw your attention to **Monday 01 July**, when activities take place away from the College site. Last year, we trialled using buses to transport girls from College to offsite activities and back, but the demands of the scheduled school 'runs' at either end of the day proved too constrictive. We are therefore concentrating the offsite activities on a single day, with drop-off and pick-up locations in proximity. We hope you will not find it onerous to arrange transport on this day.

In order to cover costs for qualified instructors and materials for the wellbeing day, and transport around the island for the Historic Guernsey day, we are asking for a payment of £18.00 per student. This should be paid at the same time as the fees for the optional activities. Please note we have a hardship fund available in case of difficulty, and applications should be made directly to the Principal.

Friday 28 June | Well-being Day (at College) Normal School hours apply

The day will include Zumba, aromatherapy (including blending essential oils), massage, and yoga. This is a whole-day activity for the whole year group. The girls should wear clothes suitable for a gym class and bring a towel, some water and a change of clothes if desired. Mats are available, or girls may bring their own. The Core will be open as usual.
