**Upper Four - Environmental Fieldwork day Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July – Petit Bôt**

Your daughter will be taking part in a Biology and Geography environmental field work activity at Petit Bôt during Alternative Curriculum Week. We will be working with members of the environmental section of La Société Guernesiaise and Guernsey Water Board. The day will start with an introductory talk led by Société about their work on the Island. The day will consist of three main activities based at Petit Bôt: a Benthic survey led by the water board, the official UK “Big Seaweed Search” and a Biodiversity survey up on the cliff path.

Your daughter should bring with her the following equipment:

- Wellies (she will not be allowed to participate in the Benthic survey without them)
- Sunhat/sun cream/sunglasses
- Waterproofs, even if there is a likelihood of rain the activity will continue
- Packed lunch and snack (money for an ice cream) – **The College ‘no nut’ policy applies**
- Filled water bottle
- Antihistamine if required
- Shoes suitable for walking on the cliff path

First aid kits will be taken by staff accompanying the girls. If your daughter needs any medication for the duration of the day, i.e. Ventolin/Epipen, please ensure your daughter has them with her.

The timings of the day are to meet at school by 08:30 and will return to school at 15:00
