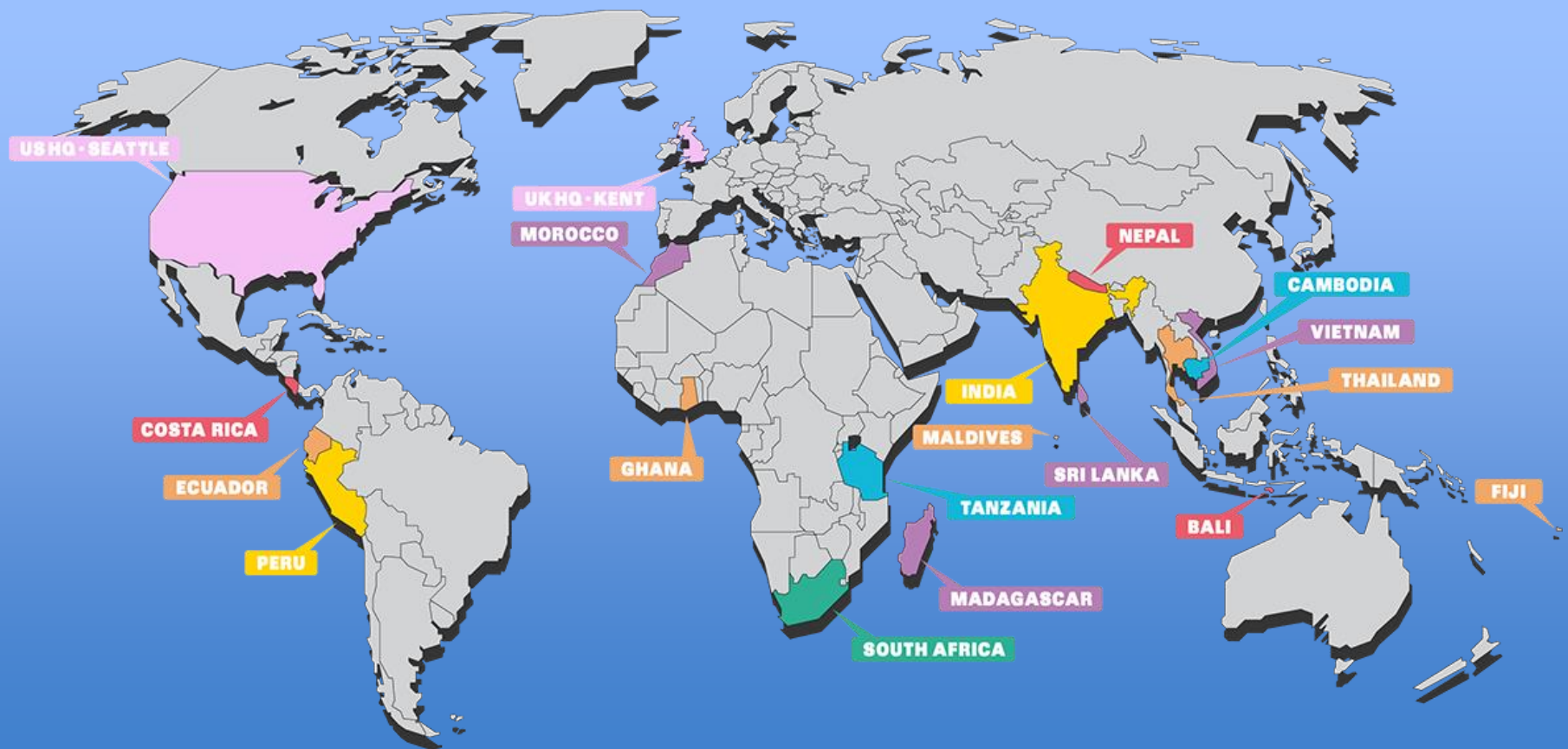

OVERVIEW

- Flagship destination – 500 participants per year
 - 14 days
 - July 2020
- Combination of volunteering & travelling
 - Fully structured from start to finish
- Transportation, meals & accommodation throughout

VISA

- 2 Options – E-Visa & Regular visa
- E-Visa – Available UK / FR issued passport holders only (£75 approx)
- Regular Visa – Online application form, obtained in advance, postal application (£119 approx)
- Ensure Passport 6 months validity / At least 2 blank pages
 - To be arranged 3 months before departure date
 - Full visa guidance to be provided

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

- Volunteer accommodation (3-8 per room – single sex)
 - Staff in private rooms
- Guesthouses / hotel when travelling
 - Western toilets and showers
- All meals included – dietary requirements to be catered for

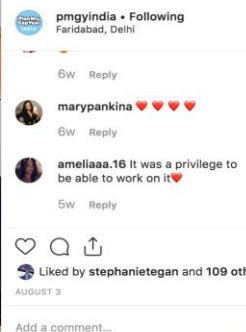
PMGY LOCAL/UK TEAMS
