

In Psychology, Ms Hagedorn demonstrated how important standardised instructions are within research, with something as simple as a cup of tea. Students were asked to write instructions on how to make a cup of tea. Ms Hagedorn then followed these to a T, highlighting the ambiguity of their instructions e.g. lack of measurements and timings, assumptions, etc. This helped students to understand the importance of clarity and precision in creating valid, reliable research, as well as a lot of grey 'pond water' tea!
