For the first time ever, our students have been invited to participate in the Charterhouse School Climate Conference on Friday, 19th June 2020. This is a combined Colleges trip.

This event is aimed primarily at Sixth Form students and it will give them the opportunity to meet both private and state school representatives to discuss the sustainability issues facing their generation.

There will be a keynote speech by Claire Perry MP and solution-oriented discussion sessions about carbon offsets, transport, food and school policies. The sessions will be supported by visiting teachers and experts who will mentor and guide the discussions.

I will be leading the trip, accompanied by Mr Aplin. We will travel by fast ferry and minibus. Accommodation will be at Charterhouse School, Godalming, Surrey.
