## Summer 2020 Examinations Upper Five GCSEs

We have now issued your daughter with her confirmation of entry and examination timetable.

Please remind your daughter to check the examination board outside the IT Office carefully to ensure she knows when and where her examinations are. This is particularly important if she has a timetable clash, however we have spoken to any candidates that this applies to. Most examinations will take place in the main Hall, however a few subjects, e.g. Music and languages, will take place in other locations. (I)GCSE candidates who are permitted additional time will normally have examinations in Room 22. *Times shown on the statements do not include the additional time allowance*.

Morning examinations start at 08:30 and afternoon examinations start at 13:30. Students are asked to arrive 15 minutes in advance of the start times and to wait quietly outside the examination room. In the event of a student arriving late, or if there are concerns over your daughter's health before and on the day of the examination, parents are asked to contact the College and myself as a priority on 721602.

## Key dates

Please remember that your daughter needs to be available to sit examinations until the JCQ exam contingency day on **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June**. There are also some other school compulsory days which your daughter must be available for. They are as follows:

- 25<sup>th</sup> June Leavers Service
- 3<sup>rd</sup> July Speech Day
