Clothing: CCF uniform. Training will go ahead unless weather conditions are severe so please be prepared to receive tired, muddy and wet cadets at 1630hrs. A change of clothing/footwear or protection for vehicles would be a sensible precaution. **Special Requirements:** Personal medication (e.g. asthma inhalers) as required.

Availability of medical treatment: Trained first aiders will be on site throughout training and a vehicle available for transport if required.

Other information: Cadets should be collected from Les Mainguys Centre at 1630hrs. Parents may wish to consider car-sharing as the site is prone to bottlenecks when traffic is heavy. Minibus transport back to Elizabeth College will be available for a limited number of cadets, provided they notify section officers in advance.
