## **October Training 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> October 2020**

We are pleased to offer details for our on island CCF training camp.

### **Attendance:**

The following Cadets should attend October Training, in order to allow them to be considered for promotion to LCpl. Those unable to attend should request leave of absence and provide reasons for absence to Captain Stewart:

### **Year 11 Army and RAF cadets; Year 13 Army Ladies' College Cadets.**

*EC Army NCOs are encouraged to attend October Training, with a view to leadership development but are under no obligation.*

### **Program:**

This Exercise is a Cadet run activity and will start after School on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October, parading at Elizabeth College at 1615 hrs and buses departing at 1630, for Rue Mainguy.

Cadet activities will be conducted under qualified CCF staff supervision, between Rue Mainguy and Fort Le Marchant, including sleeping and cooking outdoors from 1630hrs on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October until 0830 hrs on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October.

Although October Training usually returns on either Sunday or even Monday, we do understand that there are a number of commitments on Saturday mornings, particularly music. With that in mind we are making the activities on Saturday optional, and all cadets will be released at 1530 hours from Elizabeth College.

### **Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> Team Building Events:**

This will comprise two sets of concurrent activities: Military style exercises with BB guns run by Battletec (not run as a CCF activity) and further Cadet Training run by our staff.

The Battletec sessions will be run at their St Saviour/Reservoir site, the first between 0900 and 1100 and the second between 1200 and 1400hrs.

Cadets and staff will dismiss from the Parade Square at Elizabeth College.

**Cost:** The cost for this activity will be **£70**, including Food, accommodation, toilet facilities, supervision, Battletec activity, transport, rations and the use of equipment.
