## Duke of Edinburgh's Silver/Gold Award – Training & Expedition Update

I am writing to update you on the current situation following the postponement of our training day on the  $5^{\text{th}}$  February. Unfortunately, this has knock on effects with the planned expeditions coming up. Please find the revised itinerary for the Training day now planned for the  $1^{\text{st}}$  April with the caveat that we will need to be in Stage 3 to proceed.

### <u>Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April – if in Stage 3</u>

9am Silver groups will meet their supervisors at their chosen start point. They will then be following their planned route to The Ladies' College.

10.30am Gold Groups at The Ladies' College Room1,

Both groups will cover the DofE training framework including, Health and Safety, cooking their lunch on Trangia's, campcraft, and a mapping/navigation learning walk. They should therefore come appropriately dressed for DofE walking with a small rucksack including a drink, what they plan to cook for lunch and wet weather clothing.

3.00pm Gold Groups finish at The Ladies' College

4.30pm Silver groups aim to finish at their chosen end point. (They will be able to call when ready for collection)

Please can I remind you that all of the students will walk in their predetermined walking groups and be remotely supervised by a qualified member of staff when out and about.

# We will now look to run both Expeditions in the Summer (Silver Qualifier/ Gold Practice and Qualifier) as before:

This will now take place on island and/or Sark but will be DofE with a difference. To enable the student to gain the important navigation and teamwork skills, DofE Guernsey have created a list of extra activities to complete while away. These include National Navigation Award Bronze, Geocaching / Orienteering, Academic project/study, Night navigation, First Aid Scenarios of which the group must complete three in addition to their walk.
