Year 12 Geography Fieldwork June 22-24th 2021

The Year 12 Geographers are undertaking three days of fieldwork on June 22nd, 23rd and 24th.

Aim

The reason we have set-up these three days is that fieldwork is a compulsory part of the A level course. Each student is required to complete four days of fieldwork over the duration of the two-year course. The students will also collect their data for their A level coursework, which is worth 20% of their final A level mark.

What to bring?

Please bring your fully charged **laptop** into College. They can be left in Room U3 when you are out doing fieldwork. You will also need a **packed lunch**, water bottle and suntan lotion. Please wear suitable clothes for doing fieldwork, such as wearing walking kit not jeans. Check the weather forecast the night before.

Remote Supervision

Please note that there will some remote supervision on these fieldwork days, for example, when the students will be in small groups carrying out surveys in St Peter Port or taking beach and sand dune measurements along the coast in Guernsey.
