# **Duke of Edinburgh's Award Silver Qualifying Expedition**

I am pleased to confirm details for our Silver training day and Qualifying Expedition.

On Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June, Silver participants should arrive at College by 8.30am for a full day of training. They should wear appropriate clothing to complete a short walk and will need to bring lunch that can be cooked on a trangia. Collection will be from College at 3.00pm.

The Qualifying Expedition will take place on 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2021. Itineraries vary as groups will plan their own routes but please see a brief outline of arrangements below. Due to the nature of the award, students will be remotely supervised whilst journeying. During these times we will expect that the girls: stick to their planned route; notify their supervisor if they will not reach their allocated checkpoints at expected times; remain in their groups at all times.

Overnight at La Valette Campsite (pitch tent and cook dinner)

(Phones are only for emergency use and must remain sealed in the bag provided and fully charged for the duration of the Expedition)

Commence journeying (students will be remotely supervised during this time and will meet with their supervisor and assessor at agreed check points)

# 11.00am - Departure to Guernsey (boat time tbc so time may vary)

On arrival, continue journeying along route (students will be remotely supervised during this time and will meet with their supervisor and assessor at agreed check points)

Overnight at Rue Mainguy Campsite (pitch tent and cook dinner)

# Sunday 3rd October

Breakfast and strike camp

Start journeying along route (students will be remotely supervised during this time and will meet with their supervisor and assessor at agreed check points)

3.30-4.30pm – Arrive at The Ladies' College and debrief

Debrief whilst waiting for collection.
