KS3 Curriculum Evening – Monday 27th September 2021

We write to invite you to our forthcoming Curriculum Evening. We have taken the decision to run the event virtually this year, following positive feedback from similar events last year and with a view to reducing risk in our community. It will also be recorded and available for you to view at a time that is convenient to you, should you be unable to attend live. A link to this will be sent subsequently to all parents and guardians.

The presentations will start at 1830 and will be held in LC Virtual on Teams using a mixture of live and recorded presentations. It will last no more than one hour. We would anticipate that most parents will attend via their daughters' Ladies College account however if you are unable to for any reason then please provide an email address, identifying who you are, the student and your relationship to the student, to our IT support desk using ITHelp@ladiescollege.ac.gg by Monday morning so that we can set up the evening and send an invite. Note that we will only send an invite if the email address is the same as the one we hold on file as a contact address. If you are using an Apple device, we suggest that you use the Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge browsers to access Teams, unless you have the Teams Application installed on your device. Please use the ITHelp email address should you have any technical issues.

The format for the evening will be:

- I will discuss The Ladies' College priorities, our Curriculum aims and structure.
- Mr Beasley (Head of IT and eSafety Officer) will give a presentation on e-safety
- Mrs Ellis (Head of English) will explain how the English department structure their curriculum and the skills developed
- Miss Bathany (Head of Modern Foreign Languages) will look at the importance of languages and the choices students have as they move through the school
- Mr Herschel (Acting Head of Learning Support) will provide information on Learning Support and exams access arrangements.
