Dear Parents, Guardians and Students

You may be aware that two other schools on the island have taken the decision to adjust their Sixth Form provision for Friday.

My Leadership Team had reviewed our Covid plans and you will have seen in the letter that I sent yesterday, that we had every intention to avoid any last minute changes, without a clear rationale.

Whilst we continue to believe that we have made plans to try to keep our provision as normal as we can, with adjustments for Covid, we are determined that our students do not feel that they do not have some choice in how we proceed, and they make their decisions.

Tomorrow, we have our Carol Service, which will be in the Hall and House Drama. These will be streamed to be accessed either in or out of College.
