Dear Parents and Guardians,

As the production of 'Fame' fast approaches, I hope you are excited to see the fruition of your daughter's hard work on this project since the start of the academic year.

After all the efforts of the cast, we sincerely hope that the current situation will allow us to go ahead with our performances as planned, yet we are acutely aware that things can change at very short notice.

With this in mind, I write to advise you that we intend to film the matinee on Monday 24th January (the performance which would have been the schools' matinee, under other circumstances) as a contingency plan, should the public performances be prohibited by Public Health at short notice. Please be assured that we have received no indication of this, however, after our last performance of 'Grease' was cancelled last year due to a very fast-acting lockdown, I am keen that we have something in place to preserve all the hard work of our students.

The intention for the film is for it to be used internally by the college – as a record of the students' achievements – it will not be shared publicly (eg not posted on the college website).

However, if we were unable to perform, it provides us with a film which we could then screen at the college at a future date. This may also be possible if, for instance, family members are unable to watch the live performances at short notice, due to having to isolate. The latter is something we would look to organise should there be need / demand for it and would be done when the current Covid restrictions are more relaxed.
