You will have the opportunity to discuss any queries at the Lower Sixth Parents' Evening which will be an online evening on **Wednesday 2nd March**. Students should make appointments with their teachers, who will conduct the meetings via Microsoft Teams. For each subject, students simply join the Teams area they visit for their scheduled online lessons. You will be directed to a waiting 'lobby' from where the teacher will admit you at your appointed time. Your assistance in adhering to the pre-arranged timings for your meetings with teachers would be greatly appreciated.
