### **Duke of Edinburgh's Silver Practice Expedition**

During these times we will expect that the girls: stick to their planned route; notify their supervisor if they will not reach their allocated checkpoints at expected times; remain in their groups at all times.

### **Silver Practice Itinerary**

#### **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June**

7.00 - 7.30pm Students should arrive at Cobo Scout Campsite (Le Douit Boudin) and meet their supervisor. They will then set up camp for their overnight stay.

(Girls should have eaten before they arrive but can bring snacks for the evening)

#### **Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> June**

7.30 - 8.00am - Breakfast and strike camp

8.00 - 9.00am - Start journeying along route (remote supervision)

3.10pm – Boat to Sark

4.00pm - Arrive in Sark and journey to La Valette Campsite (remote supervision)

4.30 - 5.00pm - Arrive at Campsite, set up camp, cook evening meal and overnight stay

#### **Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> June**

8.00 - 9.00am - Breakfast and strike camp

9.00 - 10.00am - Start journeying along route (remote supervision)

4.00pm - Boat to Guernsey

5.00pm - Arrive in Guernsey and start journeying along route (remote supervision)

5.30 - 6.00pm - Arrive at The Ladies' College, return kit, debrief and collection
