Dear Parents and Guardians of Senior School and Sixth Form students,

I am pleased to provide details of our final celebratory events for the end of the 2021/2022 academic year.

Leavers' Service

This year's Leavers' Service has been rescheduled so all leavers can attend without the prospect of sitting a public examination the following day. The service will take place in the **Town Church** on the morning of **Thursday, 30th June**. On this day, students should attend College at the usual time in full uniform (Senior School to wear white ankle socks and Sixth Form to wear dark tights).

After morning registration, we will hold our traditional House Swimming Competition, followed by break and the end-of-year Mark Reading assembly. At around 10:50, staff and students will walk down to the Town Church for the Leavers' Service, which we expect to start around 11:30. The service should finish at about 12:30. Students who have cars/scooters/cycles may make their own way to the church, in which case parents should indicate their consent via the below form, by no later than 10:30 on Tuesday, 28th June. If we have not received consent, we will require them to walk with the main group.

Students who are receiving a prize the following day at Speech Day will be escorted from Town Church to Beau Sejour for the Speech Day rehearsal (or make their own way there if they have their own transport). They will be dismissed from Beau Sejour after the rehearsal, which we expect to end around 15:00 (16:00 for orchestral players). These students should bring a packed lunch and water bottle to school.

Students who are not receiving prizes the following day at Speech Day will be dismissed from the Town Church after the Leavers' Service. Should you not wish your daughter to be dismissed from the Town Church, she can join the group walking to Beau Sejour. She should be collected from the concourse (rear) entrance no later than 13:30.
