The Ladies' College Walkathon - Friday 24 June 2022

Following a successful first event last year, we are holding our second Ladies' College West Coast Walkathon on **Friday 24 June**. The Walkathon involves walking along the west coast from Portelet in the south to L'Ancrese in the north.

The event is about promoting active lifestyles and raising money, which will be divided between Safer Guernsey (domestic abuse) and the British Red Cross Ukraine Appeal. The walk should take around four to five hours and will cover just over 10 miles. There will be a lunch stop at Cobo kiosk plus numerous watering and toilet stops along the route.

Arrival & Finish

Students will complete the walk in their House groups. Departure times from Portelet will be staggered from 08:50 through to 10:00. Your daughter will be notified of her group and their departure time from Portelet at house meetings on Wednesday. **However, please note that staff will be at Portelet from 07:45 to supervise students who need to arrive before their group's departure time.**

We are keen to encourage active travel and suggest this would be an ideal opportunity for students to use public transport with a friend(s), particularly if they have not done so before.

We recognise that other students will need to arrive by car, and in these cases, we suggest parents may wish to arrange car sharing to reduce the number of car journeys.
