Art and Photography London trip, $26^{th} - 28^{th}$ November 2022

I am delighted that your daughter has secured a place on the Art and Photography Trip to London. The Art and Photography trip will provide students with an excellent opportunity to learn outside of the classroom and to deepen their knowledge and understanding of Art and Design. We are currently in the process of confirming itinerary arrangements, of which the overview proposal is set out below.

We will be flying from Guernsey airport to London Gatwick with onward travel by train, tube, and foot. Flight details are as follows:

The students will have an opportunity to spend time inside the galleries and explore the sites and architecture in the city, during which remote supervision will also be in effect. This means they must stay in groups of three or four, remain within a prescribed area, and report back to staff at a pre-arranged destination every forty-five minutes. The students will have the mobile number of their supervising teacher in case they need to contact them sooner.

The total cost of the trip has now been confirmed as $\pounds 420$, which includes all travel expenses, accommodation, entry to Art exhibitions, insurance and evening meals, including breakfast. However, this price does not include lunch on day two and three or spending money.
