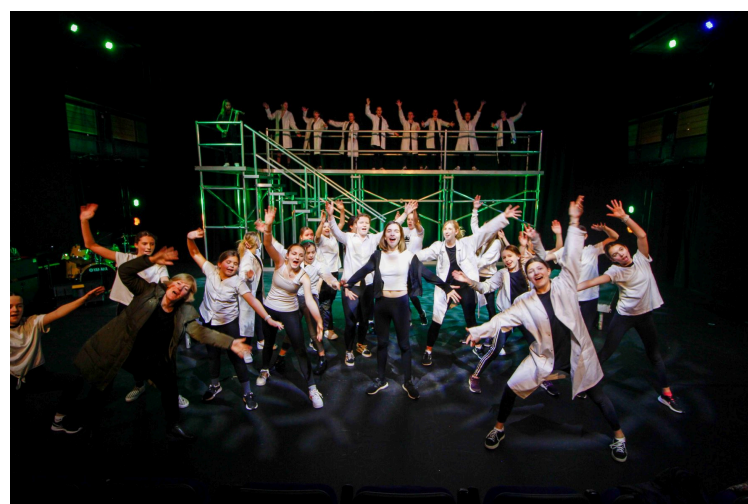
Breakthroughs
