Medical and Veterinary Science presentation, Leaf Centre classroom

This presentation will be given by Dr Marshall, Head of Science, and is aimed at potential applicants for reading either Medicine/Dentistry or Veterinary Science, particularly in Upper Five and Lower Sixth as it focuses on the specifics of the application process.

Oxford and Cambridge University presentation, Leaf Centre

This presentation will be given by Mr Barnes and Dr Smith, and is aimed at potential applicants for places at Oxford and Cambridge universities i.e. those that are likely to achieve or have already been awarded a high proportion of 8 and 9 grades at (I)GCSE. A key theme is developing an enquiring mind, in addition to specifics on the application process for each of these universities. We will also discuss the support we provide to students including developing curiosity, questioning skills, and presenting counterarguments. This talk is also suitable for those that may be interested in the equivalent universities outside of the UK such as the American 'Ivy League' universities.
