

During the trip there are some occasions (highlighted with * above) when it is more appropriate to remotely supervise students. During these times we will expect that the girls:

- Stay within the geographical boundaries of the area identified by the teachers.
- Be back by the time agreed and at the location agreed by the teaching staff.
- Remain in their friend groups of 3 or 4.
- Keep their mobile phones switched on and ensure they have the staff contact numbers including the area code in their phones.
- Always behave in a sensible manner.

On each of these occasions a member of staff will remain at an agreed location in case of difficulty while others will be roaming the agreed area.

If you **do not** consent to remote supervision, please let your daughter's group leader know and they will stay with the teachers during these times.

Can I please draw your attention to the fact that when we went in 2019, this area in France was not completely covered by mobile services and there was no Wi-Fi where we were staying. They call this area a "zone blanche" (dead zone for telecommunication).
