Lower 4 Netball and Hockey Trip 4th / 5th March 2024 – Expectations and Codes of Conduct

Throughout the trip, you will be expected to behave in a sensible fashion.

Airports:	<p>You will be registered on your arrival at the airport. The group will then check in and go through security together. A further register will be done before getting on the plane and again once through customs at the destination.</p> <p>Disembarkation in the same manner as embarkation. When in arrivals, you should stick with your key staff member and collect luggage and onwards through customs as a group.</p>
Accommodation:	<p>Students are expected to remain in their rooms throughout the agreed bedtime and not to disrupt others unless there is an emergency. Pupils will be informed of fire safety procedure on arrival. Pupils must NOT open their doors to anyone outside of the school group. One student per room should be assigned as being responsible for ensuring that the room is kept / left tidy. Pupils should not leave any valuables in their rooms. Students will know the room numbers of staff should they need them in an emergency.</p>
Mobile Phones:	<p>Students may take mobile phones on the trip, but they will be responsible for them. During “school hours” normal mobile phone expectations will be in place. They must not be used at mealtimes or during group activities. Students will be given a time after which they must not use their phones. Students may contact home if they wish, but if they are upset or homesick, they should contact a member of staff. Students must be respectful of the privacy and peace of their roommates.</p>

Kit list

Travel in PE kit (tracksuit bottoms, House t-shirt or a plain sports top, so that you can save your PE t-shirt for matches on Tuesday, waterproof top, mid layer, and trainers + a warm coat)

PJ's, Wash bag, Underwear, Casual wear for the evening e.g. leggings and jumper

Hockey Kit – astros, shin pads, socks, green skort or blue shorts, green round neck t-shirts, gum shield, stick.
