

- Non-routine problem solving (creativity, expert thinking, metacognition)
- Systems thinking (decision making and reasoning)
- Critical thinking (analysing, reasoning skills)
- ► <u>ICT</u> literacy



Interpersonal skills:


- Communication (listening, speaking, writing, and non-verbal communication)
- Collaborative problem solving (shared understanding, actions, team organisation)

Relationship building skills
(teamwork, trust,

influence, conflict
resolution, negotiation)



Intrapersonal Skills:

 Adaptability (ability to cope with the uncertain, adapting to different personalities and situations, communication styles and cultures, and other environments) Self-management and self-development (working independently, showing resilience, self-motivation, ability to acquire new information and skills in the work place)
