### Lower Sixth (Year 12)

It has been an exciting and busy start to the year with an abundance of opportunities being offered to the girls to support their Sixth Form experience.

We would like to remind both students and parents of some key dates in the calendar and also the expectations within the Sixth Form.

#### Uniform

The uniform for Sixth Form students differs from that in the Senior School, however, the expectation to follow the guidelines remains the same. The views of the girls were canvassed when the current uniform was chosen and we found they preferred to have a distinctive uniform to show they are still members of The Ladies' College, but wanted some unique features, which make the uniform more suitable for Sixth Form students. Students may therefore wear a little makeup and minimal jewellery (i.e. one pair of small earrings, fine chain necklace and bracelet.) Festival-style bracelets, ankle bracelets, white socks, tattoos or additional piercings are not acceptable.
